

Back to School

As we gear up for another academic year, before anything else, I want to wish the best and all God's blessings to all our Holy Angels Parish students and educators in whatever grammar school, high school, or university you are attending or working. I am praying for all of you that you may have a successful and good school year! As you know, from a Catholic perspective, the goal of education is to enable children to learn and develop - intellectually, physically, emotionally, and most of all spiritually - so that they can reach their full God-given human potential to contribute to the common good of society and to deepen their relationship with the Lord, leading to eternal salvation.

I was in Catholic education as a high school teacher at Paul VI High School for six years and I have learned that education plays a critical role in the development of young people. I urge parents to show constant vigilance upon what is going on at the school(s) where their children are present, whether a Catholic school or not. Please talk to your children every day and find out what their teachers are saying in class. Be prepared to offer a response to them when you find that they are "learning" things that go against our faith, as well as affirming the good and true things that they are taught. This is especially important in our current cultural environment where there are many things in the state mandated curriculum for public schools that are contrary to the Gospel and harmful to our children.

Being intimately involved in the education of your children is not just the duty of parents, but also a great opportunity to bring the light of Christ and his love to them. Don't forget - the earlier the involvement starts and more constant it is, the less likely that it will seem intrusive to the children. Also don't forget to attend every possible event in which your children participate. They may not mention it, but you can be sure that your presence means very much to them.

Now, to you wonderful students. Even though I went to school for more years than I like to remember (24 years total of formal education...ugh!), I never liked school very much. But along the way, I did learn a lot. One important thing I learned along the way is that as much as I disliked doing homework and studying, it's really important. I know now, from my own experience and from working with students, it's actually much easier to work a little bit all the time and not get behind, than to let things go and then have periods of crazy activity just to throw a bunch of stuff together just to get something in on time. You end up with better grades with less stress. It's a tough lesson to learn but it works. Try it. Have a great year!



- 1: A client advocate is part of a team of 2 people who will be on duty for 1 week every 4 6 weeks
- 2: A member of the team will check phone messages at a time convenient for them from their homes.
- 3: A member of the team will place the call to the client to determine the need of the client and eligibility for assistance by our conference (many may be referred to other conferences)
- 4: An appointment will be set up to meet the client at our office, again at a time convenient for all.
- 5: The team will meet with the client and provide any assistance required.

That's it in a nutshell. All told, you might spend 5 hours in the week doing this. And, you can do this around your schedule. You will be trained and supplied with plenty of materials to assist you. Also experienced members will always be available to help you through any complex issues.

RCIA begins after each Easter season with a rolling open enrollment and continues to the following Easter season. The process is also available for Catholics who have never received the sacraments of First Eucharist and/or Confirmation.





REPORT SEXUAL ABUSE

An independent, toll-free number has been established by the Diocese of Camden to help callers report cases of sexual abuse by priests, deacons, religious, employees and/or volunteers. Calls are handled by a licensed clinical social worker. In accord with state law, cases of child sexual abuse are reported to the N.J. Division of Child Protection and Permanency and law enforcement. Un número telefónico gratuito e independiente ha sido establecido por la Diócesis de Camden para ayudar a las personas a denunciar casos de abusos sexuales por sacerdotes, diáconos, religiosos, empleados y/o voluntarios. Las llamadas son manejadas por un trabajador social clínico licenciado.
