Justice and Charity in Speech

In our digital culture, speaking ill about another is usually very serious. With a few taps on our phone or keyboard that takes just a few seconds, one can cause great harm and suffering to others. This happens despite the claim we didn't "mean it". And the traditional way of speaking ill of others behind their back continues also to cause great harm. It is a serious wrong, a serious sin, to slander a person and hurt the reputation and honor of our neighbor. The Catechism states, "Respect for the reputation of persons forbids every attitude and word likely to cause them unjust injury."

This is especially true of rash judgment, in which one assumes as true, without sufficient foundation, the moral fault of a neighbor. Everyone enjoys a natural right to the honor of his or her name and reputation. Unjustly damaging another's honor is a grave offense against justice and charity. But how often do we judge, criticize, and condemn someone on social media or by some other method, without nearly enough or even correct information? How often do we attack our neighbors, our bosses, our employees, our fellow parishioners - anyone really - assuming the worst in a person and not even trying to find out the truth about a situation? How often do we repeat accusations, often baseless, in our conversations with others? Do we think that God will not hold us accountable for unjustly damaging a person's reputation?

To avoid rash judgment, we should strive instead to interpret our neighbor's thoughts, words, and deeds in a favorable way, rather than assuming the worst. If we need to get more information about something, go out and get it before we start commenting. And if we are the victim of an unjust attack, then our response should be one of prayer for the person, not trying to find a way of getting them back. Jesus transformed the Old Testament law of "an eye for an eye" to the New Testament law of "love your enemy". And he expects us to follow it. We should be looking for ways to build people up, not tear them down.

How can we establish a community of trust and peace if we are regularly violating the Eighth Commandment, "Thou shall not bear false witness against thy neighbor"? Even if what we think we know is true, what gives us the right to judge others and, in our judgment, cut them to shreds, when we ourselves are the same or worse sinners than the ones we condemn? We should be looking to resolve our differences rather than causing a greater divide. May the Lord help us to see the damage we can cause before we cause it, so that we may be able to hold back our hand, and our tongue, from hurting the brothers and sisters we are supposed to love.

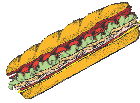

May your Spirit open conversion for those who contradict your will, that we may live in harmony. Give us the grace to be united in truth and freedom, and to always seek your will in our lives.

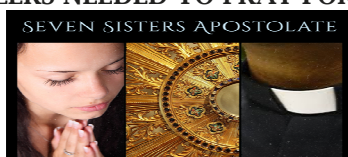

However, locally there is much work to do. There are more abortions happening now at the Cherry Hill Women's Center than before because women are coming from out of state. A staff member of the CHWC said they are seeing 35-40 out of state clients each week now.

Prayerful presence outside an abortion clinic has been proven to impact "no show" rates for abortion appointments up to 75%. Our presence is vital for women who may have last minute doubts. On the last day of August volunteers spoke with a mother who had come from Florida and she chose life for her baby instead!
