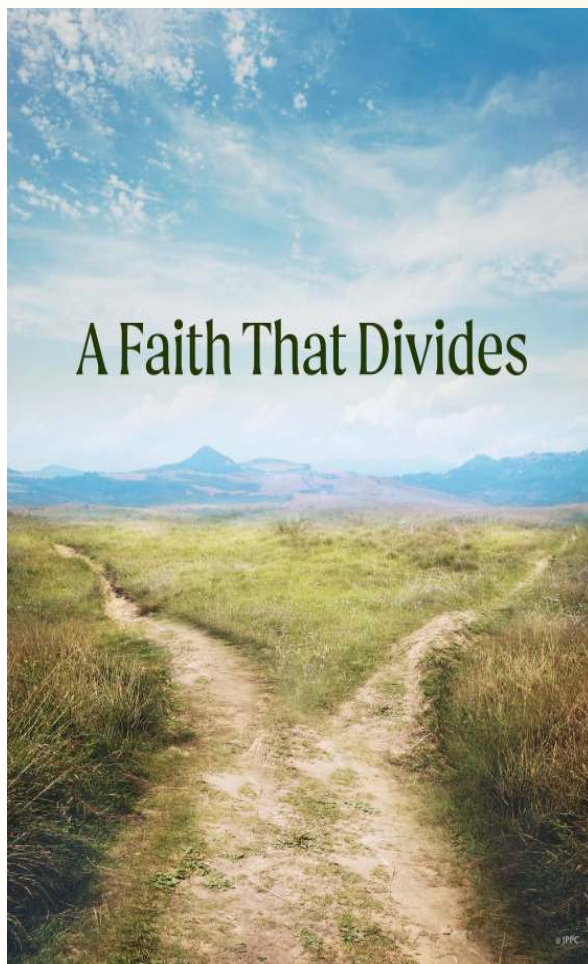

Late for Mass

Being late for Mass. Ugh. This is such a touchy subject and I kind of feel it's a lose-lose scenario no matter what I say or how I say it. At the same time, I think it's important enough to risk it. I read about ten or twelve different articles about this topic, including Canon Law, before composing this. It was interesting that the authors of those articles, some were priests and some were lay people, were surprisingly diverse in their responses. There were, however, some fairly consistent statements. Most of which seem pretty reasonable to me. First and foremost, and pretty obvious is this: being present for the whole Mass is not just the expected norm, but also the way we can get the most out of Mass and of our worship of the Lord.

Everyone also agrees that there is a huge difference between being late due to an unusual circumstance (lost keys, unset alarm, train crossing!, unexpected traffic, weather, child issues and similar things) and a habitual lateness. In the first group, there is no problem being late, there isn't much you can do about it. If you are going to be really late, (like missing half of the Mass) you might think about going to the next Mass. If it is a minute or two, then come on in! Yes, you might get a look or two, but who cares?

However, if it is the second group, those who are habitually late for Mass, especially daily Mass, I think some soul searching is needed. For example, if we replace being late for "Mass", with being late for "work" or a "meeting" or a "concert" or a "movie" or "school" or something else we can and should ask ourselves, "how often am I late for those things?" Why are we on time for those things but not for Mass? What does it say about our attitude towards our worship of God?

If one is just five minutes late for a thirty-minute daily Mass, that's about 17% late. If you work an eight hour a day job, that would equate to getting to work at about 10:30am when you were to start at 9:00am. I don't think you would be at that job too long if that kind of lateness was frequent, no matter what the excuse. And while work isn't worship of our loving Lord, which one should we be striving to be the most faithful to?

I think all of the authors state that the Holy Eucharist should not be denied to someone who is late for Mass. This is true, church law clearly confirms this. So, as long as you fulfill the other requirements for reception of Holy Communion...not conscious of a Mortal or Serious sin, having fasted from food and drink for an hour, properly disposed to receive our Lord....so if you fulfill the requirements, by all means receive the Holy Eucharist even if you are late for Mass.

Please also consider that your entrance into Mass after it has begun not only negatively affects your own experience, but can also affect others, causing them to be distracted. I can say, as a priest and looking out towards the congregation and seeing everyone, it takes a lot of focus to keep focused on the Lord and the Mass. For me, it is really difficult to remain focused when there are multiple instances of people coming in late. That's a weakness of mine that I continue to work on. And I feel as the pastor, it is prudent, in this sad day and age where people sometimes commit violence in churches, to at least give a glance to those who are coming in late, even though that can break my concentration. That's especially so when it is the same person or people that are habitually late.

So, for everyone's benefit, the individual Mass-goer, the rest of the congregation, the priest, everyone, let's do our best to not just be on time but early for Mass and give ourselves the time we need to prepare to open our hearts to the loving Lord. And if it's one of those rare occasions that you are late due to circumstances beyond your control...that's cool too.
