

The Cell Phone

I like old movies and when there is a question about an actor or actress, date, character, or award, I pull out my phone and go onto IMDB (Internet Movie Database) and get every answer to every question I can ask. And that is just one App. Our phones and the Internet and the technology behind them is nothing short of amazing and the benefits of this technology are hard to overstate. I'm not sure there are many people around who could find their way with a paper road map anymore (provided you could even find one). We just plug in the address in Waze and the directions appears on our screen, along with where the police are too!

So what I will say next is not an indictment of technology, but rather a reflection on the use of technology. Our phones, computers, Internet and related technologies are essentially a tool. And like any tool, there are ways to use it properly and morally and ways to use it improperly and immorally. Hopefully, as adults, we are able to navigate our technology use reasonably well, aside from the too many games of Candy Crush we play sometimes.

But it's a lot harder for children. With all the dramatic physical and psychological changes that come with adolescence, adding a phone to it can literally be like throwing gasoline on a fire. Earlier this year, the Surgeon General, Vivek Murthy, issued a warning that social media use is a main contributor to depression, anxiety and other problems in the nation's teenagers. Murthy calls youth mental health "the defining public health issue of our time."

According to recent data, up to 95% of teens between the ages of 13 and 17 say they use a social media platform. About a third say they're scrolling, posting or otherwise engaged with social media "almost constantly." This is a problem. Multiple studies have shown overuse and misuse of social media is linked to depression, anxiety, low self-esteem, increased suicide among teens, especially among girls.

As of last year, students in grades eight and ten who were surveyed said they spent on average three and a half hours a day on their phones. The most popular social media platforms among teens are TikTok, Snapchat and Instagram.

The use of phones and social media will not go away, and shouldn't go away. It is a valuable tool. But parents should be vigilant with how and how much their child/ren use their phones, and even if they should have one. **Parents.....remember, remember, remember....your teenage child/ren should have no illusions of privacy regarding their phone or computer. You must have complete access to every piece of technology that your child/ren possesses. And you should regularly (a couple of times a week) go through your teenage child/ren's phone and/or computer, including texts and apps and Internet history.** This is not to be untrusting or suspicious but to be the protective, loving parent God has called you to be. Teens can unknowingly (and sometimes knowingly), expose themselves, or be exposed to content and people that are a danger to them and to their souls. I have recently seen the damage that can be caused by unregulated social media use by teens, and it is very, very sad.

You need to be the moderator of your child/ren's use of technology, not them. Best practices suggest that there should be no computer in your teen's room and that their phone is left outside of their room at a predetermined time each night. Their bedroom is for sleeping and not staying up till two a.m. texting and watching TikTok videos. Also, be sure to model proper technology use to your teens by giving a good example by the way you use technology. With the new school year starting, this is a great time to re-evaluate how you moderate the technology use of your child/ren. Take action. Protecting your children is loving your children. .



FALL SCRIPTURE SESSION

The Scripture study this Fall will be **The Book of Genesis**. It will be a five sessions series covering the first half of this Biblical Book. (The Second half will follow.)

A study of the book of Genesis is an invitation not only to contemplate the creation story, but to remember with the Israelites **their ancestors in faith**. Part One of this study covers Genesis 1:1-25:18 (the “pre-history” of Israel including the creation accounts, the stories of the fall and the great flood, as well as the story of Abraham and Sarah). Commentary, study and reflection questions, prayer and access to online lectures are included.

As a believing community it is important to keep alive the cultural dimension of the Christian faith, and decisive value that biblical instruction has for issues of our time. It is not by chance that Sacred Scripture has been studied and commented upon for centuries by the generations that preceded us.

The program will begin, Thursday, September 14 at 7PM in the upstairs classroom of the Parish Center.

For those who can afford, offering is \$20 for the text. If there are difficulties with the fee, see me. We will be using as in the past the program from Little Rock Arkansas Scripture Study published through the Liturgical Press.
